





You complete, sign and email the attached sign up form to **southtawton100club@gmail.com**. All participants must be over 16.

At the same time, you will need to pay the subscription of £12 by direct bank transfer to the PTA bank account (details on sign up form).

If joining part way through a school year the subscription will be less – please check with Emma Vann Jones before making payment.

This buys you one membership number (which we will allocate), and enters you into the monthly draw. The first draw will be at the end of September of each year.

The draw will take place during assembly, or at another suitable occasion, on the last week of each month (Sept- July).

If you win, the money will be available the following week and the name of the winner published in the school's weekly newsletter.

The prize money will be 40% of the membership fee taken that month. The remaining 60% will go towards funding equipment, resources and opportunities for pupils.

South Tawton School PTA RULES RULES

Purpose

The purpose of the 100 Club is to raise funds. The money will be paid into the PTA bank account and used to meet funding requests from the school, providing equipment, resources and opportunities for pupils.

RULES

- For a cost of £12 per year you will be allocated one number between 1 and 100. There will be 11 draws per year (Sept-July, with December being allocated £2/number)
- 2. A draw will be made every month with a 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize (except August)
- 3. The prizes will total 40% of the monthly income.
- 4. This will be apportioned as: 1st prize of 25%, 2nd prize of 10% and 3rd prize of 5% for 11 months. This also will be the same for December, but the prize will be based on £2 per number.
- 5. The 100 Club is a private lottery and is open to all parents, carers, staff and friends of South Tawton School. Anyone age 16 or over can join.
- 6. Payments must be made annually.
- 7. Member's numbers will only be entered if their subscription is up to date.
- 8. If a member has no valid reason for missing a payment, their number may be sold to someone on the reserve list
- 9. The draw shall be made by the Head Teacher in an assembly during the last week of each month, or at another suitable venue.
- 10. The winning cash/cheque will be available to collect from the school office within one week of the draw.
- 11. The name and numbers for each month's winners will be posted in the school newsletter and on other advertising media we may use.
- 12. The 100 Club will be run by the PTA. In case of any dispute the decision of the Committee is final.
- 13. Unless otherwise advised, a member will be deemed to have left the 100 Club if his/her subscription renewal remains unpaid for a period of one month

- 14. If a winner cannot be contacted, the winnings will be placed into PTA funds after six months.
- 15. If we sell all 100 numbers we will have a waiting list. We reserve the right to increase the amount of numbers to a 150 or 200 Club, but will advise all members of the 100 Club accordingly.

PRIVACY NOTICE

As part of the General Data Protection Regulations, we need to inform you about what data we hold and why.

- 1. We will collect your name, email address, postal address and telephone number for the purposes of contacting you and creating a membership number. We process only information supplied directly to us by the Member at the time of joining the South Tawton School PTA 100 Club ("100 Club") and from time to time subsequently.

- 5. We take all reasonable security measures to protect the data and will keep your records in a secure way and will not share them with any other parties.
- 6. A Member may request removal of all or part of their data at any time.
- 7. When you cease to be a Member of the 100 Club we will securely delete/destroy your information.

- 9. A Member can be reminded of the data held at any time on request.
