What to do in case of cuts and grazes:



- 1. Clean and dry the wound.
- 2. Apply a dressing or plaster.

What to do in case of heavy bleeding:




- 1. Apply pressure to the wound.
- 2. Call 999 for an ambulance.
- 3. Maintain pressure until assistance arrives.

What to do in case of choking:



- 1. Hit them firmly on the back between the shoulder blades.
- 2. Check for breathing or that the item is dislodged.
- 3. Call 999 and start CPR, if necessary.

What to do in case of head injury:



- 1. Sit the person down and apply something cold to the injury.
- 2. Call 999 if the person becomes drowsy or vomits.

What to do in case of a burn or scald:



- 1. Cool under cold running water for 10 minutes.
- 2. Cover with plastic food wrap.
- 3. Call 999 if necessary.

What to do in case of an asthma attack:

- Help the person to sit down and take their medication (e.g. inhaler).
- 2. Reassure the person.
- Call 999, if the attack worsens or they have no medication.
