Spellings:

In spellings this week we will be focusing on some easy words (e.g bus, rope, try) but the focus is on adding plural 's' and the use of apostrophe 's' for possession. Perhaps you could remind yourself the following rules:

Rules for plural 's'

- Most nouns add '-s' in the plural
- Nouns ending in a hissing/buzzing/shushing sound add '-es' because it makes it easier to say (lunch, fish)
- · Nouns ending in '-y' change the 'y' to 'i' and add '-es'
- Several nouns ending in 'o' add '-es' (potato), but newer words just add '-s' (radio) how confusing!!

Apostrophe 's is used for


- Contraction: He is = he's
- singular possession: The cat's tail
- plural possession: The children's toys (if it ends with an 's' already then just use an apostrophe e.g Chris')






