Year R Superheroes Assemble



Phonics- Live lesson at 10am today I dressing up if your child would like to.

Superheroes assemble and be ready to tell us who you are and a bit about your character.

Please send me a photo of your child dressed up so I can include them in the class webpage's superhero gallery

Literacy- Write about the superhero you have chosen to dress as. Use your Fred fingers and Fred talk to sound out the words. You could tell us; what they do, where they live, what they look like/ describe their outfit, what their powers and likes are. (Adults, please give pointers, but the spelling can be phonetic – as the children would sound it).

Dance & Music- choose a superhero themed song so you can create your own superhero dance. Can you make up superhero poses and moves (weaving around laser beams, high leg kicks, ducking, using your powers, crawling). You could perform it as a dance or make it into a game like musical superhero statues.

(you can find your music using you tube, Spotify, CDs and various music streaming sources)

Maths- watch the episode of Numberblocks about subtracting 1 fewer (10 green bottle) https://www.bbc.co.uk/iplayer/episode/b08r41qb/numberblocks-series-2-ten-green-bottles

You can use real peas, playdough balls or other items. Line up 6 and then roll the dice to see how many to take away (or squish!) – children will have great fun squishing the dough or peas. You can vary the amounts you start with as children become more confident. Adults can give the calculation for children to set up (e.g 10-7) and squish.





PE & Funky Fingers (exercising those fingers to support hand eye coordination). Here are few topical ideas.

- Collect peas using a cocktail stick or tweezers
- Pop bubble wrap- can you have a race or cut it into shapes before completing?
- Mash potatoes or use a masher for other items (outdoor in the mud, in paint, on a sponge to squeeze the water
- Cut or peel vegetables or fruit.
