Monday 22nd February Year R - Home Learning

This Half term we are finding out about different places around the world. This week we look at the celebrations of Chinese New Year and find out about Asia.

Literacy- Write about something you did in the half term holidays. I know we're not able to go out much at the moment but perhaps you went for a walk, had an online chat or built something? You could use pictures or photos.

Live lesson at 10am. We will find out about our new topic and discuss our half term.

Maths- Today are thinking about ordinal numbers (1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th etc)

Make your own 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th markers. Gather 6 different teddies or items. Throw each and see how far they go in the race. Once they have all been thrown place the markers for each to see who was 1st, 2nd etc.

You can extend this by making a ramp and sending items down the ramp. You can explore who 'won' by coming 1st and why.
