
## Wednesday 27<sup>th</sup> January Year R - Home Learning

**First aid-** Share the posters (on class webpage) and discuss what to do with a graze, bumped head, cut, choking, burn, asthma. You could act this out using a teddy. <u>Pretend</u> to call 999 and explain this is for real life emergencies when a grown up asks you to or the person you are with cannot speak. You can practise bandaging (you could use toilet roll if you don't have a bandage), taking temperature and first aid.

**Creative-** Make your own hospital or doctor's role play at home. Does your cuddly toy need a check-up, temperature taken, a bandage or medicine? Perhaps you need to write them a prescription. Use your first aid skills from above.
