
Thursday 28th January Year R - Home Learning

Phonics- Live reading and writing session at 10am.

Literacy – Complete the reading activity sheet(s) from the class webpage. Once you have read the sentence you draw in the missing part of the picture. You could read it and *talk* about what's missing if you are not able to print and draw.

Maths- Today and tomorrow we are thinking about capacity. You will need different sized containers (a cup, mug, squash bottle, jar, etc) and a small scooper such as an egg cup or washing powder scoop. Count how many scoops of water it takes to fill each of the containers. Make an estimate of how many before you start filling each one. You can write down your findings of how many and think about why ... do taller containers always hold more liquid? *Have fun practising your pouring skills.*





SCARF session with Harold the giraffe in a scarf- Today we are thinking about what to do when you feel unwell. There is an activity sheet to complete and discuss with your child.
